Before Test Day

- Download the Bluebook exam app on the device you'll use on test day.
[Download Bluebook](#)
- Log in to the app with your College Board account and complete exam setup. Bluebook will load your exam onto your device and generate your admission ticket.
- Print your admission ticket or email it to yourself.
- On the application homepage, go to **Practice and Prepare** and try a test preview or a full-length practice test.

What to Bring on Test Day

- **Your fully charged device.** You must have the app installed and exam setup complete.
- **Your admission ticket.** You'll show this to the proctor when you check in.
- **[An approved photo ID.](#)**
- **A power cord and/or a portable charger.** We cannot guarantee you'll have access to an outlet during testing. Your device should be able to hold a charge for 3–4 hours.
- **A pencil or pen.** Scratch paper will be provided—do not bring your own.
- **[An approved calculator.](#)** There's a graphing calculator built into the app, but you can bring your own if you like.
- **An external mouse** if you use one.

Taking the Test

- On test day, arrive at the test center 15 minutes before your test begins.
- Your proctor will check your admission ticket and photo ID when you get to your room.
- When you sit down, you'll connect to Wi-Fi, log in to Bluebook, and complete a short check-in process in the app.
- Before the test, your proctor will read some short instructions, collect any prohibited items, and give you a start code. You'll enter the code into Bluebook and the test will begin.
- The digital SAT has two sections—Reading and Writing, and Math.

- Each section has two parts called modules, and each module is timed separately. You can move back and forth between questions in a module and review your answers until time expires.
- Between sections, you'll get a break. Follow all instructions on the Bluebook break page.
- At the end of the test, Bluebook will submit your answers automatically. **Do not close your device until you see the "Congratulations!" screen.**
- If your submission fails for any reason, you'll see instructions in the app to complete your submission.

Nice to Have:

- Breakfast before you arrive
- A watch (without an audible alarm)
- Extra batteries and backup equipment—you'll have to ask for permission to access them. They can't be on your desk during the test.
- A bag or backpack
- A drink or snacks (for your break)
